Uniform Policy

School vision:

In our safe and supportive school, we provide lessons full of challenge, inspiration and real life learning in order to promote independent, respectful, high achievers who step out of their comfort zone, smiling.

Introduction

It is our school policy that all children wear school uniform when attending school, or when participating in a school-organised event outside normal school hours.

Aims and objectives

Our policy on school uniform is based on the notion that school uniform:

- Promotes a sense of pride in the school;
- Engenders a sense of community and belonging towards the school;
- Is practical and smart;
- Identifies the children with the school;
- Prevents children from coming to school in fashion clothes that could be distracting in class;
- Makes children feel equal to their peers in terms of appearance;
- Is regarded as suitable wear for school and good value for money;
- Is designed with health and safety in mind.

Listed below is a complete list of the items needed for school uniform:

EYFS to Year 2

- White polo shirt with school logo;
- Navy blue round neck sweatshirt or cardigan with school logo;
- Dark grey trousers, shorts, skirt or pinafore;
- Plain dark socks (for boys);
- White knee / ankle socks or dark grey tights (for girls);
- Dark blue gingham dresses (for girls in the summer term only);
- Shoes to be plain black with no logos or colour flashes;
- Hair ties/hair bands plain navy or white – no decoration or glitter;
- No nail varnish;
- Earring to be plain studs only;
- Navy blue book bag with school logo;



Year 3 to Year 6

- White shirt with navy and silver strip tie;*
- Navy blue v-neck sweatshirt or cardigan with school logo;
- Dark grey trousers, shorts, skirt or pinafore;
- Plain dark socks (for boys);
- White knee / ankle socks or dark grey tights (for girls);
- Dark blue gingham dresses (for girls in the summer term only);
- Shoes to be plain black with no logos or colour flashes;
- Hair ties/hair bands plain navy or white – no decoration or glitter;
- No nail varnish;
- No makeup;
- Earring to be plain studs only;
- Navy blue book bag with school logo;

PE Kit – all years

- White cool-tee t-shirt with school logo
- Navy blue shorts with school logo (for boys)
- Navy blue skort** (for girls)
- Navy blue tracksuit ***
- A pair of plimsoles or trainers
- Navy blue PE bag with school logo

**On joining KS2 all children will receive a tie. Further ties can be purchased from the school office.*

***Skorts can be purchased from any high street retailer. Please contact uniform supplier if you require a school logo added.*

****It is expected that children representing the school in sporting events wear a school logo tracksuit. Otherwise any plain navy blue tracksuit is optional for the colder weather.*

All clothing and footwear should be clearly labelled with your child's name.
